# Programmes Offered

## Programmes under Calicut University Four Year Undergraduate Programme (CUFYUGP)

**BA / BBA / B.Com / BTTM / B.Sc/ BCA (6/8 Semesters)**

In 2024-25, Universities in Kerala have started four-year honours degree programmes with an option for doing three-year undergraduate degrees as well. The programmes are introduced with an option for the students to study a combination of subjects of their choice.

A three-year degree programme is embedded as part of the new four-year degree programme. Any student joining a four-year degree programme can exit with a three-year degree if he is able to earn 133 credits within three years. If a student wants to acquire more knowledge on the subject and develop skills related to the programme, he can continue and opt for the honours programme in the fourth year and can get honours degree by acquiring a total of 177 credits.

## ADMISSION

Candidates who have passed plus two or equivalent examination recognized by the University of Calicut are eligible for degree admission and candidates who have passed degree or equivalent examination recognized by the University of Calicut are eligible for PG admission. Applications for UG and PG admissions are through Calicut University Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) except Management and Sports quota. The application forms for admission under management quota are available from the college office on payment of the prescribed fee. The filled in application should reach the office within the date fixed by the University/Government.

The selection for admission to 50% of the total seats in each programme is by the University under CAP, and the remaining 50% is under management quota.

3 % of seats are reserved for the physically handicapped students. Two seats in each UG Programme are reserved for students outstanding in Sports & Games at the University, the State or the National level.

Those who are provisionally selected for admission will be called for interview. Parents or guardian should accompany their wards. The following certificates/documents should be produced at the time of interview.

Students are advised to keep sufficient copies of their certificates and mark lists before submitting them to the college office

1. CAP Registration form
2. Admit card in case of merit quota
3. Mandatory fee receipt
4. SSLC or equivalent certificate.
5. Higher Secondary or equivalent certificate
6. Transfer and Conduct Certificates from the institution last attended.
7. Self-attested copies of SSLC and Higher Secondary certificates.
8. Two copies of passport size photo.
9. Degree/ Provisional Certificate and consolidated grade card of the qualifying examination with self attested copies in case of admission to PG Programmes
10. Certificates from the competent authorities in case of students claiming weightage under NCC, NSS etc.
11. Relevent Certificates in case of Sports/PH quota admissions.

# FEES STRUCTURE

## 1. COLLEGE FEES

Students have to remit the tuition fee per semester in **June** and **November**. Those who fail to remit the fees in the stipulated time will be removed from the rolls of the college and have to undergo readmission procedures after clearing all the dues in the college. Students will have to remit the fees of the academic year in full if they leave the institution before completing their programmes.

## 2. UNIVERSITY FEES.

Students have to remit the mandatory fee ( University Union fee and Sports Affiliation fee) for each year, and University Examination fee for each semester examination, as prescribed by the University for time to time.

# RULES and REGULATIONS

- Timely remittance of tuition fees, mandatory fees and university examination fees is compulsory.
- In accordance with orders of Supreme Court, High Court, Government of Kerala and University of Calicut, Ragging is strictly prohibited inside and outside the campus. Ragging is a punishable offence with two years imprisonment along with fine.
- Students are expected to maintain dignity and decorum on all occasions.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited inside the campus as per Government order. Offenders will be levied fine and the mobile phone will be confiscated.
- Students should not loiter in varandas
- Indecent behavior towards teachers and fellow students will result to serious punishment.
- Students should produce leave letter signed by parent / guardian in case of absence.
- 75% of attendance is compulsory to apply for the University examinations.
- Attendance of the parent in the PTA meetings is compulsory .
- Students shall compulsorily wear their identity tags whenever they are present in the college campus.
- All payments, issue of certificates, mark lists etc. will be made on production of the identity card.
- The identity card shall be surrendered to the office at the time of issuing of Transfer Certificate. Identity card is valid till the completion of the programme of study.
- All the U.G. students must wear uniforms prescribed by the college each year without fail on all working days.
- Entry of students in the campus in special dress code for functions or ceremony is prohibited
- No fund shall be collected or no meetings shall be organized in the college campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Students shall park their vehicles only in the parking area.
- No vehicle shall ever park in such a manner as to block or obstruct another vehicle, doorway, or driveway, at any time for any reason.
- Smoking, use of intoxicants, pan masala and narcotic drugs are strictly prohibited in the campus.

## 1. PREVENTION OF RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS - SUPREME COURT DIRECTION

If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the college authority, the concerned student will be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, such student would be expelled from the institution.

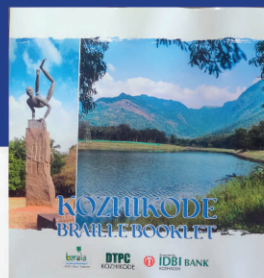
